- Purpose:** Provide Timberon community residents with FREE informative and “how to” instruction in the basics of metal working, woodworking, automotive preventive maintenance, electrical fundamentals, and various craft / hobby areas of interest.
- Class Objective:** Each student will learn hand and power tool identification and proper use, safety requirements and “hands on” projects which will strengthen and reinforce learning.
- Age Level:** 12 years (6th grade) and older.
- Instructors:** Ed Carlson, retired vocational teacher with 28 yrs experience in public schools (6th – 12th grade) and community colleges.
Also, other community members with various skill sets who would be willing to volunteer their services.

In order to get this program started, some basic shop items/tools are necessary. In order of importance, they are:

1. 4 workbenches (wood or metal)
2. 10 stools (wood or metal)
3. 4 medium size bench vises
4. Miscellaneous hand tools – saws, wrenches, pliers, hammers and etc.
5. Miscellaneous wood and metal pieces (scraps ok)
6. Tool storage (tool boxes or cabinets)
